

Terms & Conditions

Overview

The following terms and conditions (the "**Volunteer Terms and Conditions**") will apply to all volunteers selected by the Supreme Committee for Delivery and Legacy ("**SC**") ("**Volunteer**") in relation to the Community Engagement Volunteer Programme (the "**Programme**") run by SC. The Volunteer Terms and Conditions consist of two parts: Part A detailing the roles and responsibilities of the Volunteer and SC; and, Part B dealing with the terms of use applicable to the use of the Volunteer Programme website at <https://volunteers.qa/volunteers/index.php> (the "**Volunteer Website**") (the "**Terms of Use**") which can be found on the Volunteer Website at: <https://volunteers.qa/volunteers/index.php>.

The Volunteer Terms and Conditions are in addition to other applicable notices, guidelines and rules that may be published by the SC on its website at <https://www.qatar2022.qa/en> (the "**SC Website**") (the "**SC Website Terms and Conditions**"). For the avoidance of doubt, in the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the SC Website Terms and Conditions and the Volunteer Terms and Conditions, the Volunteer Terms and Conditions shall prevail.

The Volunteer is required to read these Volunteer Terms and Conditions carefully. By using the Volunteer Website, the Volunteer acknowledges that the Volunteer has read, understood, accepted and agreed to be legally bound by these Volunteer Terms and Conditions and by all applicable laws and regulations governing the Volunteer Website and relating to the protection of the intellectual property owned by or licensed to SC. The Volunteer is only permitted to enter the Volunteer Website if the Volunteer agrees to these Volunteer Terms and Conditions.

To the extent that an individual is accepting and agreeing to these Volunteer Terms and Conditions on behalf of a Volunteer under the age of 18, that individual acknowledges and agrees that he will be fully responsible and liable for their compliance with these Terms and Conditions to the same extent that he would be liable or responsible for any breaches of the Volunteer Terms and Conditions.

These Volunteer Terms and Conditions will be governed by and construed in accordance with Qatari law and will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Qatar.

These Volunteer Terms and Conditions have been drafted in the English language. In the event of any discrepancy between the English and any translated text of the Volunteer Terms and Conditions, the English text shall prevail.

No Liability to the Volunteer

SC and its affiliates exclude all representations, warranties, conditions and terms express or implied by statute, common law or otherwise to the fullest extent permitted by law. SC and its affiliates accept no liability for any special, indirect, incidental, consequential or economic loss howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with the Volunteer Terms and Conditions, the Volunteer Website, and/or the Volunteer Terms of Use. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as offering the Volunteer or any other party any services whatsoever.

Indemnity

The Volunteer agrees that the Volunteer shall indemnify and hold harmless SC, its subsidiaries, affiliates, including but not limited to the Qatar Football Association, directors, officers, employees, members, agents, partners and licensees from any and all claims, liabilities, cost or expenses, arising from any and all liabilities, losses, damages, claims, penalties, fines, costs and expenses, including without limitation, reasonable legal fees, that may arise in connection with (i) Volunteer's participation and provision of voluntary services as a Volunteer; (ii) Volunteer use of this Volunteer Website; (iii) Volunteer's breach of these Volunteer Terms of Use; (iv) SC publication, distribution or use of such materials provided by Volunteer (including Contributions); (v) any claim by a third party that any content provided by Volunteer (including Contributions) to the Volunteer Website or any other use of the Volunteer Website by Volunteer infringes any intellectual property, other proprietary or privacy right of such third party or has otherwise caused damage to a third party

Any failure by SC to exercise or enforce any rights under the Volunteer Terms and Conditions and/or the Volunteer Terms of Use shall not constitute a waiver of such right or provision and SC shall continue to have such rights to the extent permitted by applicable law. To the extent any provisions under the Volunteer Terms and Conditions and/or the Volunteer Terms of Use is found to be invalid, the Volunteer and SC agree that the intentions of SC, as reflected in such provision, shall be given effect to the fullest extent possible under applicable law and that other provisions of the terms remain in full force and effect.

PART A – Volunteer Terms and Conditions

Volunteer's Role and Responsibilities

In the event of selection as a Volunteer by the SC, the Volunteer accepts and agrees to abide by the following terms & conditions:

- The Volunteer's services will be provided on a voluntary, pro bono basis and will not in any event or circumstances be considered as employment.
- The Volunteer will respect and abide by the instructions, policies, codes of conduct and rules of the SC, and all rules, regulations, traditions and customs in the State of Qatar, together with any specific policies, codes of conduct or instructions that may exist in relation to a specific event.
- The Volunteer, if selected by SC, shall enter into a Framework Volunteer Agreement.
- Pursuant to the terms of the Framework Volunteer Agreement the Volunteer shall, if and when invited by SC to participate in a specific event, respond in a timely manner to the Event Call-Off Order confirming the Volunteer's ability or inability to provide the volunteer services required.
- The Volunteer is fully aware of any potential risks and will not take any action that may risk his or any other person's safety.
- The Volunteer will look after and safeguard all materials, equipment, products and assets provided by the SC, and will return them to the SC at the end of the volunteering services.
- The Volunteer will notify the SC of any concepts, ideas or materials that he may create or develop in connection to the voluntary service. The Volunteer understands that, for any such creations or materials, all intellectual property rights, copyrights and other rights shall

be immediately, without charge, assigned to SC, and agrees to do all acts and things necessary to give effect to such assignment.

- The Volunteer shall not engage, or assist any other person to engage, in any media, advertising, marketing or general social media comments or promotions relating to:
 - the SC, without prior written approval of the SC; or
 - any other organisation or project any other organisation or project which conflicts with the objective of SC, while Volunteer is performing volunteer services.

SC's Rights and Responsibilities

- The SC will provide adequate insurance coverage for the Volunteer while the Volunteer is undertaking voluntary services that have been approved and authorised by the SC.
- The SC reserves the right to refuse the Volunteer's application to participate in the Programme for any reason, including if the Volunteer fails to meet SC's security requirements and/or standards, or for failing to pass any other checks performed by the relevant authorities in the State of Qatar.

Volunteer's Consents and Acknowledgments

- The Volunteer authorises and consents to being treated by SC's medical team in the case of a medical emergency.
- The Volunteer acknowledges that the SC reserves the right to refuse the Volunteer's application to participate in the Programme for any reason including those reasons stated herein.
- The Volunteer acknowledges that all events in relation to which the Volunteer's services could be provided, may be documented and/or filmed, and that videos or photographs of the Volunteer may appear in the media or be used by the SC or its affiliates, as deemed appropriate, and the Volunteer expressly consents to such use.
- The Volunteer acknowledges that the SC, relevant authorities in the State of Qatar and other third parties carefully selected by SC (as detailed and for the purposes contained in the Volunteer Privacy Policy available at: <https://volunteers.qa/volunteers/index.php>), may use the Volunteer's personal data for any lawful purpose, to which the Volunteer hereby consents. Further information regarding the use of personal data can be found in the Volunteer Privacy Policy available at: <https://volunteers.qa/volunteers/index.php> .
- The Volunteer acknowledges that in the course of providing the voluntary services, the Volunteer may have access to confidential information relating to the SC and/or the event or activity. The Volunteer undertakes not to use or disclose this information to any person or entity, either during or after my voluntary service and to otherwise comply with the terms of confidentiality set out in the Framework Volunteering Agreement.

The Volunteer acknowledges and accepts the responsibilities and risks associated with their agreement to provide the volunteer services, and further acknowledges and accepts that there is a certain degree of personal risks involved in delivery of the volunteer services and the personal perils to the volunteer, both foreseen and unforeseen, are all fully accepted by and solely assumed by the Volunteer. For the avoidance of doubt, the Volunteer expressly acknowledges and agrees that in volunteering there could be

an increased risk of exposure to COVID-19, for which the Volunteer fully accepts the personal risks associated with the same.

Termination of Voluntary Service

- In the event that the Volunteer wishes to withdraw their application or cease voluntary service, the Volunteer will give the SC notice in writing at least three business days before the Volunteer wishes to cease providing their services.
- The SC reserves the right to terminate or suspend Volunteer's voluntary service at any time, without prior notice and may withhold Volunteer's accreditation card and any other access cards.

Amendments to the Term and Condition

The SC may change these Volunteer Terms & Conditions without prior notice. Any changes to the Volunteer Terms & Conditions shall be posted on the SC Website and/or Volunteer Site, and such posting shall constitute constructive notice to the Volunteer of any and all revisions and changes effective from the date of posting.

PART B – Website Terms of Use

Changes to the Terms of Use

SC may revise any part of these Volunteer Terms of Use or any other notices, guidelines and rules otherwise incorporated by reference to these Volunteer Terms of Use at any time. As a condition of using the Volunteer Website, the Volunteer is required to check these Volunteer Terms of Use regularly to take notice of any changes SC makes as they are legally binding on the Volunteer. By using the Website, the Volunteer agrees that the posting of new or revised Volunteer Terms of Use on the Website shall constitute adequate and constructive notice to the Volunteer of any and all revisions and changes. The Volunteer refers to the user or viewer of Volunteer Website. The content of the Volunteer Website is for the Volunteer's general information and non-commercial use only. Access to the Volunteer Website is permitted on a temporary basis, and SC reserves the right to withdraw or amend access to the Volunteer Website without notice (see further below). SC will not be liable if, for any reason, the Volunteer Website is unavailable at any time or for any period. From time to time, SC may restrict access to some parts of the Volunteer Website, or the entire Volunteer Website.

Certain features of this Volunteer Website require that Volunteer creates an account or otherwise interact with the Volunteer Website.
